2025 SCHOOL FEES

Please be guided by the 2024 School Fees which is **R28 670.00** per annum per learner. AFTER SCHOOL CENTRE (ASC)

Please be guided by the 2024 fee which is R8 860.00 per child per annum. A pre-payment of R886.00 per child is payable upon acceptance to secure your child's place and will form part of the 2025 ASC fees. The registration fee is non-refundable if you do not inform us that your child will not attend the ASC in 2025. The After School Centre has limited space and Parents need to apply every year. The registration fee must be paid for all applications.

GRADE R STATIONERY

The fee for stationery in 2024 was R650.00. The increase in fees is subject to budgetary requirements and approval by the Parents Annual Budget Meeting scheduled in October 2024, date to be confirmed.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Only children born between January and December of the year they turn six will be considered.
- Admission may be granted to learners of parents residing in the defined feeder area (residing implies ownership of a dwelling or leasehold or rental thereof) subject to availability of classroom space. All learners residing within the feeder area or have current siblings will be placed on an "A" Waiting List.
- The feeder area is defined by the Governing Body as per the South African Schools Act, Act 84 of 1996.
- <u>Foreign Learners</u>: In accordance with the Immigration Act, Act 13 of 2002, Sections 13 Study Visa, Section 23 Asylum Transit Visa and Section 25 Permanent Residence Permits. Immigrant Regulations (GG 37679 dated 22/05/2014) learners who are non-South African citizens *must be in possession of a valid Study Visa*.
- Water Safety: As swimming forms part of our Physical Education curriculum all learners must be water safe.
